

## RULES

Hilton Park Campground welcomes you.

Please observe the following rules for the comfort and safety of all.

**VIOLATORS OF THESE RULES MAY BE EVICTED WITHOUT REFUND.**

1. **NO WOOD GATHERING.** Do not gather firewood or driftwood. Please do not deface, cut or clear trees or shrubs. We need to preserve the campground's natural beauty.
2. **SPEED LIMIT 5 MPH.** Please drive slowly and carefully within the park for the protection of our guests. Watch for children playing, especially around the playground.
3. **Pets must not be left unattended.** Please keep your pets on a leash at all times and contained in your RV, Tent, or Cottage at night. Constantly barking or annoying dogs may be required to leave. County leash law is enforced. (Pitbull, Pitbull mixes, or any other aggressive dogs are not allowed.)
4. **Camp in prepared sites only. No open air sleeping.** Please do not move tables or fire pits. Build your campfire in pit provided. Pits available on request if needed. No ground or beach fires.
5. **Please play horseshoes in prepared pits, not in campsites.**
6. **Please be considerate of others.** Always keep radio volume low and observe evening quiet hours. No disorderly or disrespectful conduct will be allowed.
7. **QUIET HOURS.** Please obey the posted quiet hours.
8. **Off-road driving is not allowed on the beach.**
9. **No weapons of any kind are permitted on the campground.** This includes "Look-a-likes"
10. **Discharging of gray water on the ground is prohibited by state law.**
11. **Beach and playground closes at dusk.** Please monitor young children.
12. **Guest must comply with all federal, state and local laws.**

Campers, renters and all other users of this property are liable for all property damages.
